Tui Community is featured in the book *Creating Harmony: Conflict Resolution in Community*. Robina McCurdy is a New Zealander who also identifies as a planetary citizen. She is a co-founder/resident/trustee of Tui Land Trust & Community and a founder/trustee of the Institute for Earthcare Education Aotearoa. She is both a State and Steiner trained primary school teacher, and has a Permaculture Diploma in Trusteeship, Media and Education, and qualifications in Seed Technology. Robina has been engaged in broadscale community development, with 18 years in permaculture design and teaching, organic growing, the development of environmental education resources and the creation of participatory processes for decision making and collective action. She has taught and applied these powerful community-building methods with households, neighborhoods, schools, farms, ecovillages and bioregions, in Aotearoa/ New Zealand, Australia, South Africa, Ireland, Brazil and USA.
